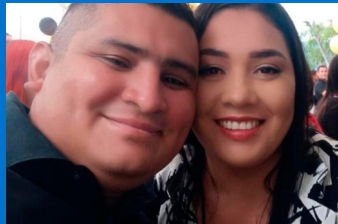
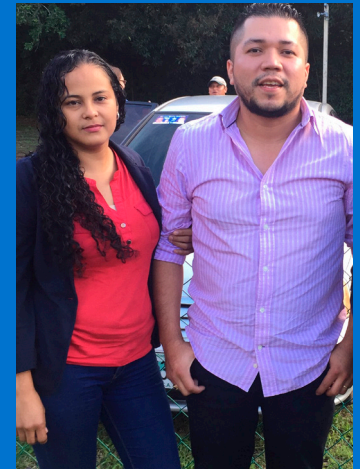
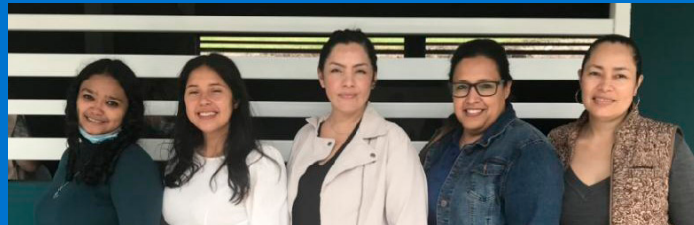


HONDURAS

We are humbled and grateful to be a part of God's ministry in Honduras. The Lord continues to bless even during our absence. He has placed people to serve alongside us to help assure His ministry continues.



The new school year started in February and The Manna Project continues to provide the students with daily meals. We have now added 3 more schools to the project bringing the total to 14! For those who have served with us in the past, these new schools are in Tatumbla on the backside of Uyuca Mountain in an area called Macuelizo. The ministry now serves 1402 students 25,274 meals a month. The feeding project for the seniors has expanded and is now serving 130 seniors, assuring that meals are provided to them when they visit the community center for their monthly health checks.



With the addition of the 10th grade added to the Hope for the World High School, we now have a total of 81 students enrolled and one new teacher. All the new students were blessed with a youth study Bible.



The church in Cofradia that the ministry partners with continues to grow and now has 168 in attendance, along with 61 kids in children church. The ministry was once again able to provide Bibles to all those who needed one. They now have 11 home groups throughout Tatumbra that meet weekly to disciple and help many grow in their faith. There have been 9 salvations in this New Year!



The 2022 Christmas Project was a huge success and provided all the teachers in Tatumbra with much needed school supplies for each classroom. They were all so very appreciative.



Thank you to Gary and Teresa Waters for hosting the annual Pheasant Shoot at Hartland Farms. This event is such a blessing and is used to help further God's Kingdom in Tatumbra. Thank you to all who participated and for the many who helped in so many ways to help make this event a success.

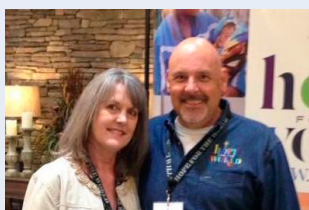
