*Through a generous donation from a team member who came to serve, HFTW was able to help fund a project to help a school with a serious and dangerous drainage problem. This not only helped the school, but also provided income for the men of the community who completed the work.*



*HFTW sponsored the Science Exhibition at one of the schools. The children are so innovative and creative! The winners received awards, provided through another donation given through the ministry.*



*The new HFTW High School held its first awards day. We were so proud of the 5 students who received the award of academic excellence from HFTW.*



*HFTW is able to provide monthly food and diapers for a sweet baby named Valeria, whose mom passed away right after giving birth. This is a tremendous blessing for the grandmother who is doing a great job of taking care of her granddaughter.*



*HFTW is participating with the community to provide meals for 70 senior adults once a month during a health screening project that was started by the mayor's office.*



*The team from our home church, Cornerstone Baptist in Hartwell, Ga., led by Jennifer London, came and ministered in the schools, and participated in door to door evangelism throughout the community. Many lives were touched and we praise the Lord for the 16 salvations!*
