HONDURAS

“TRUTH” - is not merely a set of facts, but a moral and spiritual concept rooted in God’s unchanging character, reliability, and faithfulness.

***Truth:** Honduras has among the lowest education indicators in Latin America, not to mention it’s the 2nd poorest country in Central America with roughly 60-73% of its population living in poverty, with over half living in extreme poverty. High household poverty rates of this magnitude significantly impact educational outcomes throughout the country. Poor families have almost no access to education beyond the 6th grade. Although school is provided by the government through 6th grade, many are unable to attend because families are unable to afford uniforms & school supplies. Not to mention the government only provides food for the children for just 30 days out of the 270-day school year, which in turn creates an almost unteachable atmosphere. Only 51% of the children registered complete primary school, and on average students that do make it through primary school still only complete 8 out of the 13 years of compulsory schooling, due to poverty, child labor, migration, violence, insecurity, & teen pregnancy. “Truth”, Only 30% of all Honduran children go to High School, as the government does not provide free education passed the 6th grade. The high school dropout rate faces a severe crisis with 53-55% dropping out due to poverty, gang violence, the necessity for children to work, and lack of access in rural areas. This in turn hinders their development and does not give them much hope for the future. But...Praise God our father in heaven has other plans, as he builds His kingdom in the village of Tatumbla in Honduras. The “Truth” of God’s word is powerful, and in Jeremiah 29:11 its says: For I know the plans I have for you declares the Lord, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you a hope and a future. God called us to serve the country of Honduras many years ago because He has a plan for a hope and future for those children in Honduras, to help meet their physical need but most of all their spiritual need by feeding, clothing, and then teaching them about the Bible and the saving grace of Jesus Christ. Helping them to become all they can be by finding freedom and purpose in Christ, knowing He is a God of grace and restoration. Training them to become Christian leaders in their own village, to help build strong Christian community so they with Christ as their model learn what it means to be a servant follower of His by reaching out to others within their country. A BIG thank you to all of you who help to pray and support God’s ministry in Tatumbla. The fruit of your faithfulness to Him is seen through all He is doing in the hearts and lives of these men, women, and children. To God be the glory, and may His blessing abound in your lives! His “Truth” is being proclaimed, and is setting the captives free, as we watch Him raise up His “Army of Truth”!! HERE WE GO*

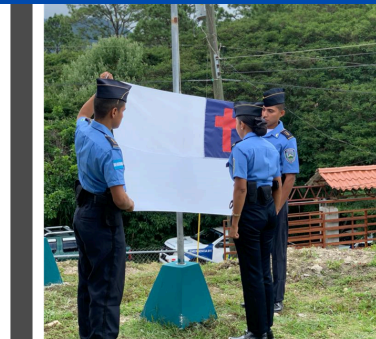
"Truth": This is the most children being fed in the history of the ministry!
