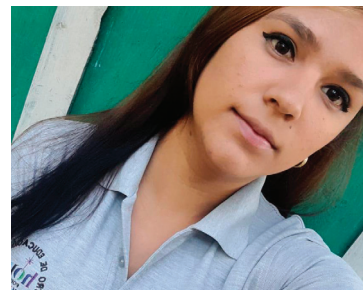
I will always have those memories in my head. I loved to share time with Larry and Marsha, and I would like to continue having that time.

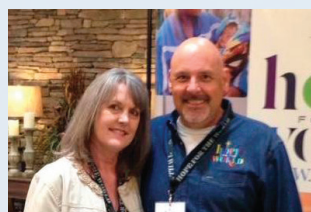
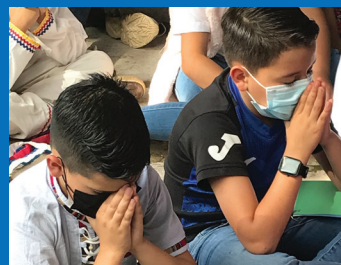
MANNA PROJECT:
