We are so grateful to you who pray, love and support this ministry. As we reflect over this past year we have so much to be thankful for. We would like to share with you some highlights of the great things God has done in 2019.

We praise Him for:

- 165 salvations!
- 740 Bibles distributed along with 4 teams who came and served
- 183,400 nutritions meals served to school children through the Manna Project. Elderly feeding project instituted with 70 being fed monthly
- 3 more schools added bringing the total to 10 schools now in the project
- Wheelchair provided for an elderly lady who suffered a severe stroke
- Moved to a new house in the Village & ministry truck paid off
- 500 lbs of beans and rice distributed during door to door evangelism
- The property in Tatumbla installed a temporary fence and Storage building. And will now be the home of the new High School § Hope Center.
- Supplies provided for 33 classrooms through the Christmas Project
- 25 women who continue to be discipled through Ladies discipleship class
- Sponsored Soccer Tournament & Science Fair for the schools
- · Marsha completely healed of stroke
- Britney is now walking!! She is a child in the project who has Crystal Bones Disease and had never walked in her life until now!
- Drainage system installed & completed for one of schools in the village
- God allowed us to house a sweet § loving family during their adoption process of an adorable little 3 yr old girl from Honduras.
- Hope for the World High School finished its first year successfully with 43 students § 5 teachers who excelled academically § spiritually.



With that said the Hope for the World High School is in need of having their own property and facilities to ensure that the Lord's army will continue to grow in strength and in knowledge. God has already blessed the ministry with the property in Tatumbla, and it has been made clear to us that part of this property is to be used for the HFTW High School. The teachers and students are super excited about this decision as well as all the people in the community. With this decision they know that their children will always have the opportunity through the love of the Father to further their education to help take their place in society, and to help give them "a hope and a future". (A little side not here is that Jeremiah 29:11 is the actual scripture that is inscribed on their uniforms). You see God began to put things in place for this change of plans by recently providing the ministry with a new home within the village of Tatumbla. This has been a miraculous development that only God could have orchestrated. We of course will continue with the plans to build the "Hope Center" to be used for discipleship ministries, and it will also be instrumental in providing a place for special events for the high school as well. The Prayer Garden is definitely still in the plans to be built on the property too as a place of solitude and reflection on all that God has done in and through His ministry. The Mayan Stone Fundraiser Project still continues and these stones will be placed in the beautiful garden alongside the Hope Center. Just a reminder that for \$150 you can purchase a Mayan Stone and we will gladly have it engraved with your choice of words or scripture up to 35 characters to be placed in the garden, with all proceeds going to the construction project. We are so grateful to God for all of you who continually lift us and this ministry up in prayer, and for those of you who partner with us financially and being obedient to the call to come and serve alongside us. Together with the Lord as our guide many lives are being changed for His glory and honor!
