



HONDURAS CHRISTMAS PROJECT & 2020 PRAISE REPORT

Dear Family and Friends,

2020 has been a difficult year for us all and has presented many challenges in ministry. Praise the Lord that He, the God we serve, is sovereign over all! As we reflect over this past year we have so much to be thankful for. We would like to share with you some highlights of the great things that God has done this past year despite the many obstacles that came our way.

We praise Him for:

- Hope for the World High School completed its second year with 60 students enrolled and 4 graduates.
- The 10th and 11th grades were approved for the HFTW High School by the Secretary of Education in Honduras which will allow the students to complete all the grades necessary in preparation for entry to college or technical school.
- Study Bibles and discipleship materials were provided to the high school students.
- The HFTW High School students and teachers completed a community project to build a playground for the younger elementary students.
- Internet and /or lesson copies were provided to the students which enabled them to continue their education via remote learning.
- A new church plant in the Cofradía area of Tatumbula was established. This is where the Women's Ministry meets, and also where many of the ladies and their families are now attending. The ministry has been able to provide chairs, Bibles, teaching resources, computer, sound equipment and a projector.
- Food and supplies provided for The "House Of Love Discipleship Project" for the children in Tatumbula, started by one of the school directors.
- The 1 year old triplets received their much needed supply of medicines, food, formula and diapers.
- Assistance provided to Christian (the triplets brother), to attend a technical school to become an auto mechanic.
- Diapers, food and formula provided for 2 year old Valeria who is being raised by her grandparents.
- The miracle of the massive forest fire that was contained within 100 yards of the mission home in the village.
- 59,720 meals served to the children and senior adults before the lock down due to Covid.
- 1,136 families provided with food bags since the lockdown.
- Financial aid provided for an elderly lady to purchase her necessary monthly medicines since her tortilla business was shut down due to the economic crisis the pandemic has caused.
- Our Honduran friends who share the vision of HFTW ministries and help us to continue the ministry during our absence.
- The annual Pheasant and Dove Shoots held at Hartland Farms in Hartwell, Georgia. And their participants, that raised funds to help with the construction of the new HFTW High School building on the property in Tatumbula.
- 5 salvations, including an 84 year old woman who gave her heart to Jesus after she received a food bag!
- Good health reports for Marsha after a series of abnormal blood labs after our return to the USA.
- Our partners and supporters of this ministry who continue to pray, love, and give generously to accomplish much for His Kingdom!
- 2019 Christmas Project that provided supplies for 43 classrooms.
